The morning workshop was on Seminole piecing. Linda Walker began the workshop by giving a simple history of Seminole quilting. Twenty people attended the workshop. Members picked out three strips of fabric and sewed them together. Then they cut them into 1 ½" pieces and then sewed them back together slightly offset. These strips all turned out very nice.

The meeting began at 1:00 P.M. with Judy Lyon presenting a nice program on modern quilting. Modern quilting is similar to the fifties with a lot of color. It follows the theme of less is more. Modern quilters are in a hurry and want something that can be done quickly. Stripes, circles, and a lot of texture are big. Improvisation is often used.
