Dear Gala Quilt Members and Fans,

Our meeting in May was a busy one. The meeting was called to order by President Bettyanne McGlinchey. There were 27 members present and 1 visitor.

Vice President Juanita Christian gave a report on upcoming activities. They are as follows:

June: Rosemary Dekker will present a morning program on getting your quilts ready to quilt.

Juanita Christian will do a workshop in the afternoon on making a zipper bag from a quilted placemat.

Brown bags will be picked up and returned in July with 3 fat quarters and information inside the bag.

Using the information inside the bag and fabric in the bag you will make a gift for the original owner and the bags will be exchanged at our December meeting.

July: Juanita has a surprise planned for our morning program.

The Skill Builder Workshop will be led by Audrey Bergeron on Half Square Triangles.

The Ice Cream Social will be between our morning program and afternoon workshop. We need volunteers to help set up, clean up, and bring toppings, etc.

Saturday July 29,2023 will be our Kitchen Sink Workshop led by Kim Scarborough at 1<sup>st</sup> United Methodist Church, 1600 5<sup>th</sup> Ave. Phenix City. Hours will be 10:00 am to 4:00 pm. Cost is \$10 per person. Maximum of 20 people. 18 seats have been filled. We will have a Pot-Luck Lunch (Soup Salad Sandwiches Dessert). Volunteers will be needed to set up Friday afternoon.

August: Agnes Grimes and Becca Chester will present both the morning program and afternoon workshop. The program is on continuous binding strips. Our Quilt Show was reported to be a success by Frances Thomason. The Quilt Committee has a meeting and discussed some changes for our next show. Extra Large Quilt sizes will be limited.
