

Pioneer Day Quilt Exhibit, April 26, 2025

This year there will only be a display of quilts that members of Gala Quilt Guild have made. These can include the Panel/Round Robin quilts, the Savannah quilt, or any others made as part of a guild sponsored class.

The special category is **SAMPLER QUILTS**. A sampler quilt is made of many different blocks. Your sampler quilt does not have to be a recent one – it can be any age, as long as it was made by you.

All of these quilts will be displayed in the main area of the Visitor's Center at Ft. Mitchell.

- **A label with the name of the quilt, name of the maker, and approximate date the quilt was made must be attached to the back of the quilt – preferably on the bottom right when looking at the back of the quilt.**
- **Each quilt entry must be submitted in a cloth bag (presentation case) that can tie or be secured, such as a pillowcase. The exhibitor's name, phone number, and quilt name should be clearly marked on the bag.**
- **In order to be hung – quilts should have a ~4 inch sleeve attached to the top back of the quilt.**
- **An Entry Form should be filled out for each quilt that is entered.**
